## **DONNA SPENCER | Director**



Donna Spencer is the Artistic Producer of the Firehall Arts Centre. Her many theatre directorial credits include Reflections on Crooked Walking, Yellow Fever, Mary's Wedding, House and Home, Social Studies, Refuge, The Yoko Ono Project, The Unnatural and Accidental Women, Reading Hebron, Mom Dad I'm Living With a White Girl, Only Drunks and Children Tell the Truth, The Ecstasy of Rita Joe, This is How We Got Here and many others. She is the winner of the Jessie Richardson Outstanding

Direction Award for *Urinetown*, the Musical and for *Reading Hebron*.
